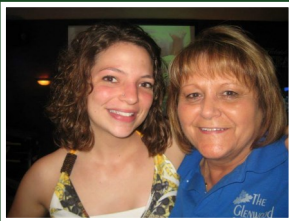


A Note from Alyssa
